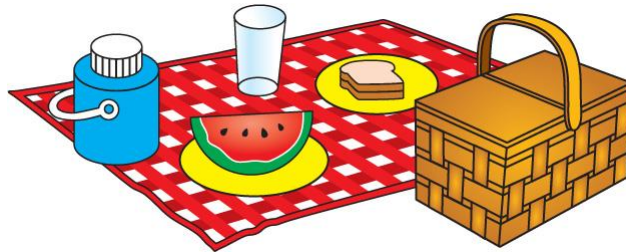

From the Desk of Social Services

Much of the following was taken from a publication by the Office of Ombudsman for Long term care and the MN Board on Aging.

What is Family Council? A Family Council is a group which operates by and for families of persons who live in nursing homes and boarding care homes. Family Council participants advocate for the well-being of their relatives by partnering with them in promoting and enhancing quality of daily life.

Residents who consider close friends or associates "family" may also participate in the family council. You can participate if you have a close relationship with a resident at Prairie Manor.

In Minnesota, Resident and Family Councils emerged in the 1970s. In 1985, Minnesota created the Resident and Family Advisory Council Education (RFACE) program that offers education resources for Resident and Family Councils.

There are many benefits to participating in Family Council. Family Councils can have educational programs about a variety of topics. Residents can benefit from an increased involvement from family members. Families can get to know staff better. Families can receive support and encouragement from each other. There are a variety of things that Family Council can do. We will help you with ideas if you're interested.
